Clergy Reflection

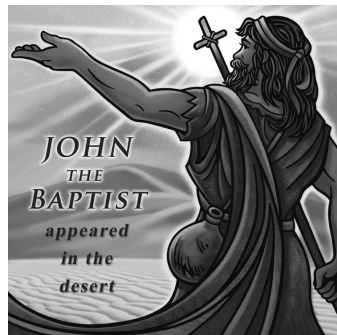
Messenger's Of God

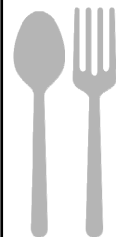

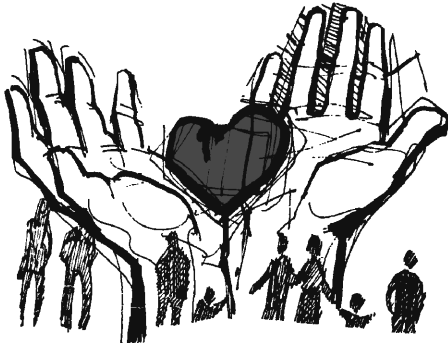

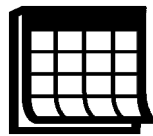
